Request for Amendment

Gentlemen:

Baltimore Gas and Electric Company hereby requests an Amendment for Operating Licenses DPR-53 and DPR-69, for Calvert Cliffs Nos. 1 and 2 respectfully, with the submittal of the enclosed proposed change to the Calvert Cliffs Security Plan Revision 10.

PROPOSED CHANGE

Incorporate Appendix 4 to the Calvert Cliffs Security Plan to allow for devitalization of vital areas during cold outages.

DISCUSSION AND JUSTIFICATION

The changes, as outlined in the Security Plan, would be effective during outage periods for either Unit 1 or Unit 2. The changes would enhance the ability to make needed safety changes with relaxed security requirements in those areas where the potential for sabotage is low. While in a shutdown mode, protection of certain vital areas are much less important because a sabotage attempt would not pose an immediate danger to the health or safety of the public.

The appendix is considered Safeguards Information and must be protected under the 10CFR73.2l requirements.

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SAFETY COMMITTEE REVIEW

The appendix to the Security Plan has been reviewed by our Plant Operations and Safety Review Committee and they have concluded that implementation of this change will not result in an undue risk to the health and safety of the public.

FEE DETERMINATION

We have determined, pursuant to IOCFR170.22, that this amendment request consists of both a Class I and III amendment for Calvert Cliffs Unit No. 1 and 2, respectfully, and accordingly, we are including BG&E Check No. B075443 in the amount of \$4,400.00 to cover the fees for this request.
