Gentlemen:

This letter is being submitted in accordance with the Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2, Environmental Protection Plan (EPP) Section 3.2, which stipulates that the NRC shall be notified within 30 days following the date of approval of a change to the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.


By letter dated February 17, 1994, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources (PA DER) approved our request extending the period for continuously discharging 450 gpm of make-up water from the Perkiomen Creek Storage Tank to Possum Hollow Run through Outfall 020 as a method of providing freeze protection for the Perkiomen Creek Storage Tank. This extension will expire on April 30, 1995, or upon renewal of NPDES Permit PA0051926, whichever occurs first. A copy of the PA DER letter approving this permit change is attached. The NRC was previously notified of our request to extend the period for continuously discharging the make-up water by letter dated January 27, 1994.


This is in response to your January 27, 1994 letter to James Newbold, requesting an extension of the approval to discharge Perkiomen Creek water to Possum Hollow Run to provide freeze protection to the Perkiomen Creek makeup storage tank.

We hereby extend the approval to discharge 450 gpm of water continuously from the Perkiomen Creek storage tank to Possum Hollow Run at outfall 020. This approval will expire on April 30, 1995, or upon renewal of the subject NPDES permit, whichever occurs first.

The approval is subject to conditions 1, 2 and 3 contained in the original approval dated November 17, 1992.
