RESOLUTION NO. 4-83

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHSPIRE, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REAFFIRMING RESOLUTION 5-79 AND SUPPORTING THE POSITION OF THE GOVERNOR OF PENNSYLVANIA ON TMI RESTART AS INDICATED IN HIS JUNE 2, 1983 LETTER TO THE NRC.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council on July 17, 1979, after a July 5, 1979 public forum, resolved that the Three Mile Island Nuclear Facility be permanently closed; and

WHEREAS, more than four years after the March 28, 1979 accident at TMI Unit 2, decontamination and removal of fuel has not been completed; and

WHEREAS, General Public Utilities, owners of TMI Units 1 and 2 are petitioning the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for authority to operate TMI Unit 1; and

WHEREAS, operation of Unit 1 is perceived as a threat to area citizens; and

WHEREAS, Governor Dick Thornburgh on June 2, 1983 sent a letter to the Chairman, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission urging postponement of restart until certain issues have been satisfactorily addressed and resolved;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Highspire Borough Council supports the actions of Governor Thornburgh and reaffirms its belief that TMI Unit 2 be decontaminated and defueled as safely as possible and that TMI be permanently closed as a nuclear facility.
