This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. Z. Falevits, P. Wohld and R. Smeenge of this office on October 21-23, 30-31, and November 1, 1985, of activities at LaSalle County Station, Units 1 and 2, authorized by NRC Operating Licenses No. NPF-11 and No. NPF-18 and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. R. Bishop and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.
