

electronic fund transfer No. 064236000000258.

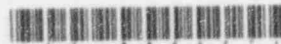
