Gentlemen:

By letter dated March 12, 1997, the NRC staff requested that Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company provide written responses to a request for additional information. The NRC request relates to the plant-specific summary report on resolution of unresolved safety issue (USI) A-46 program at the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant (BSEP), Unit Nos. 1 and 2. A response was requested within 30 days of receipt of the letter (i.e., by April 18, 1997). Based on the extensive nature of the information requested, additional time is needed to prepare the response. Therefore, CP&L will provide written responses by June 17, 1997. The extended response schedule has been discussed with and agreed to by the NRC Project Manager.
