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NRC STAFF MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL BRIEF REGARDING CCNC CONTENTIONS 16, 17, AND 18

The NRC Staff moves the Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Board to extend to Monday, February 24, 1986, the time for all parties to file their supplemental briefs regarding CCNC Contentions 16, 17, and 18.
