
- Reference: 1) TVA letter to NRC dated December 6, 1996, "Sequoyah Nuclear Plant (SQN) - Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (UFSAR). Amendment 12 and 10 CFR 50.59 Report"
 - 2) T\'A letter to NRC dated February 12, 1997, "Response to Request for Information Regarding Adequacy, Availability, and Control of Design Bases Information"

In Reference 1, TVA submitted the Amendment 12 update to SQN's UFSAR. The Amendment 12 update provided resolution of discrepancies within SQN's UFSAR that were identified in Phase I of TVA's UFSAR Verification Program.

Completion of Phase II to TVA's UFSAR Verification Program, involved a TVA commitment for issuing Amendment 13 to SQN's UFSAR. Reference 1 provided a June 6, 1997 completion date for this commitment. TVA's reference 2 letter iterated this TVA commitment for continuing reviews of SQN's UFSAR, evaluating remaining discrepancies, and preparing the required changes to the SQN UFSAR. Additional time is needed beyond the June 6 commitment date to complete an indepth review of changes associated with SQN's UFSAR for Amendment 13. TVA is conducting additional reviews by designated design/system engineers to validate original UFSAR text. Accordingly, TVA is extending the due date for these commitments from June 6. 1997 to September 6, 1997. This extension will allow completion of the reviews AU5310 necessary to close Phase II.
