Based upon a thorough review of the staff's rigorous and risk-informed analysis of the site-specific exemptions to scale the emergency preparedness and planning (EP) requirements commensurate with the permanent cessation of operations and permanent removal of spent fuel from the Unit 1 reactor vessel to the spent fuel pool at the Three Mile Island Nuclear Station site, I approve the requested exemptions to 10 CFR 50.47(b) and Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50. I appreciate the staff's coordination efforts with the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency, as documented in SECY-20-0041, Enclosure 1. As noted by the staff, these exemptions are authorized by law, will not present an undue risk to the public health and safety, and will be consistent with the common defense and security. Such an exemption would still require that Exelon maintain an onsite emergency plan, which would provide for the notification of, and coordination with, offsite organizations, to an extent commensurate with the approved exemptions.
