




to the same extension being granted to the other parties (and no objection to the Staff being given, as customary, an additional 5 days, that is, until August 20).

The reason CPCo requests this delay is that Fred Williams, the attorney responsible for this matter, is on vacation in Europe. The other attorneys in CPCo's law firm who are familiar with the Midland proceeding are fully occupied with ongoing hearings before the NRC Licensing Board in the Braidwood proceeding. CPCo does not believe this delay will prejudice any party.

I am authorized to state that counsel for the NRC Staff has no objection to the requested extension (assuming the Staff's own time to respond is extended to August 20). I have not been able to contact Ms. Stamiris or Ms. Sinclair.


