On January 18, 1999 an empty beer can was located within the protected area inside the Unit 2 "B" containment accident fan. The empty beer can was found lying on its side inside a "C-channel" above the cooling coils. It was likely that the can existed in the location for many years, probably since initial plant construction. The incident was tracked under condition report 99-0223. There was no operability concern due to the relatively secure manner in which it was situated in the channel.
