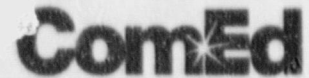

This report is being submitted to make the following commitment:

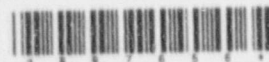
Modification DCP 9500057 to install flow indications to the Residual Heat Removal System and CS Room Coolers is planned to be installed on Unit 1 during Q1R15.


