NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Please take notice that in the captioned proceeding a prehearing conference will be held on May 12, 1989, at 9:30 a.m. in the U. S. Customs House, Courtroom 300, Second and Chestnut Streets, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

The conference is called pursuant to the Order of the Commission of April 14, 1989 calling for a Licensing Board to conduct proceedings to consider the contention of an inmate questioning whether the radiological emergency response plan relating to the Graterford Institution complies with the standard of 10 C.F.R. §50.47(b)(15) that radiological response emergency training is provided to civilian personnel (e.g., bus and ambulance drivers) who may be called upon to assist in the event of an emergency that

would require evacuation of the Graterford prison. The Commission action was taken in furtherance of an opinion issued February 28, 1989 by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit granting a petition for review filed by Intervenor Thomas Martin. <u>Martin v. NRC</u>, No. 87-3190, slip op. at 69-71, 77.

The following matters will be considered:

- Simplification, clarification, and specification of the issue;
- (2) The obtaining of stipulations and admissions of fact and of the contents and authenticity of documents to avoid unnecessary proof;
- (3) Identification of witnesses and the limitation of the number of expert witnesses, and other steps to expedite the presentation of evidence;
- (4) The setting of a hearing schedule; and
- (5) Such other matters as may aid in the orderly disposition of the proceeding.

The parties or their counsel are directed to appear.
