I. <u>SECY-21-0022 – HOLTEC INTERNATIONAL (HI-STORE CONSOLIDATED INTERIM</u> <u>STORAGE FACILITY), FASKEN LAND AND MINERALS APPEAL OF LBP-20-10 AND</u> MOTION TO REOPEN

The Commission.¹ approved a Memorandum and Order addressing an appeal by Fasken Land and Minerals, Ltd. and Permian Basin Land and Royalty Owners (together, Fasken) of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision denying Fasken's motion to reopen the record and admit an amended contention, and to address Fasken's motion to reopen the record and admit its proposed Contention 3. The Memorandum and Order denies the appeal and the motion.
