Furnished herewith is OQAM Revision 36 pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 50.54 and 10 CFR 50.71, and 10 CFR Part 72. The OQAM has been revised to incorporate changes since the last docketed revision transmitted via Reference 1.

The following are provided as attachments to this letter:

1. Description and Justification for Proposed Changes to the OQAM
2. OQAM Revision 35a mark-up, identifying changes through the use of strikeouts and inserts
3. Updated pages which constitute OQAM Revision 36

Revision 36 incorporates OQAM Change Notices (CNs) 21-002, 21-003, 22-002, and 22-003. The changes in this revision include:

- OQAMCN 21-002 changes the Callaway Energy Center title from "Director, Nuclear Oversight" to "Manager, Nuclear Oversight." There are no changes to reporting relationships or assigned responsibilities as described in the OQAM.
- OQAMCN 21-003 changes commitment from Regulatory Guide 1.8, "Qualification and Training of Personnel for Nuclear Power Plants," Revision 2, dated April, 1987 to Regulatory Guide 1.8, Revision 4, dated June 2019 only for Radiation Protection (RP) positions of First Line Supervisors, Technicians, and Supplemental Personnel.
- OQAMCN 22-002 revises the wording of OQAM 1.2.2 that describes the frequency of the review performed by the Senior Vice President and Chief Nuclear Officer for the independent review of matters involving safe operating of the plant from "at least once per twelve months" to "at least once each calendar year." Based on the US NRC SER letter to Nuclear Management Company, dated January 13, 2005 (ADAMS Accession # ML050210276).
- OQAMCN 22-003 provides clarification and editorial changes by revising OQAM 1.3.2 to clarify QC activities, OQAM 1.7.1 to reflect renaming of the Health Physics department to Radiation Protection, removes "ISO/IEC 17025:2005," and adds the issue year "-1978" to ANSI N45.2.6 and ANSI/ANS-3.1.

Change Notices 21-002, 21-003, 22-002, and 22-003 were reviewed internally and determined to not represent reductions in commitment to the Operating Quality Assurance Program as previously accepted by the NRC. The OQAM continues to maintain its focus on activities affecting quality, consistent with importance to safety, including compliance with 10 CFR 50 Appendix B requirements.


