FIFTH ANNUAL REVIEW OF APPLICATION-SPECIFIC,

RISK-INFORMED REGULATORY GUIDES AND THE

ASSOCIATED STANDARD REVIEW PLANS

In a staff requirements memorandum (SRM) dated June 29, 1998, the Commission directed the staff to (i) perform annual reviews and updates of application-specific, risk-informed regulatory guides (RGs) and the associated standard review plans (SRPs) and (ii) consider experience gained from risk-informed programs when updating the guidance documents. The related RGs and SRPs are as follows:

- RG 1.175 and SRP Chapter 3.9.7, "An Approach for Plant-Specific, Risk-Informed Decisionmaking: Inservice Testing"
- RG 1.176, "An Approach for Plant-Specific, Risk-Informed Decisionmaking: Graded Quality Assurance" (no SRP issued)
- RG 1.177 and SRP Chapter 16.1, "An Approach for Plant-Specific, Risk-Informed Decisionmaking: Technical Specifications"
- RG 1.178 and SRP Chapter 3.9.8, "An Approach for Plant-Specific Risk-Informed Decisionmaking Inservice Inspection of Piping"

The previous annual reviews were provided to the Commission on August 30, 1999, August 21, 2000, August 28, 2001 and October 4, 2002. In the 2003 review, we discuss these four RGs. and propose to discontinue the current periodic reporting requirement for them and replace it with progress updates via the Risk-Informed Regulatory Implementation Plan (RIRIP), which is revised semiannually.

#### RG 1.175 and RG 1.176

There are no plans at this time to revise RG 1.175 and RG 1.176 and the associated SRE chapters.
