

I approve the staff's recommended plan for disposition of these Tier 2 emergency preparedness items.

My only concern with this approach is the "voluntary initiative" nature of the action related to multiunit dose projection. Avoiding these types of initiatives, when regulatory requirements may be more appropriate, was a finding of the Near-Term Task Force, as they stated, "[V]oluntary safety initiatives by licensees can enhance safety if implemented and maintained effectively, but should not take the place of needed regulatory requirements." In this case, given the industry's willingness to commit on the docket until future rulemaking can take place, I agree that Orders would not be the most efficient use of agency resources. However, the staff should keep the Commission informed regarding licensee compliance with their stated commitments and subsequent NRC-endorsed guidance on multiunit dose assessment. If compliance issues arise, the staff should return to the Commission to propose regulatory requirements (i.e., Orders) to ensure timely implementation.
