# Commissioner Svinicki's Comments on COMSECY-14-0028 Agreement State Program Policy Statements: Update on Recent Activities and Recommendations for Path Forward

I approve the staff's plan to combine certain previous Commission-directed tasks into a single notation vote paper, to be transmitted to the Commission in November 2014 and to include: a consolidated, single policy statement for Agreement State programs; a recommendation for assessing compatibility of Agreement State radiation control programs; and a recommendation to revise, replace, supplement, or expand the IMPEP performance metrics. I note that the two, operative Staff Requirements Memoranda (SRM) related to this request convey some very particular views – established by the Commission in its deliberations on the underlying matters – regarding the substance of the Commission's policy statements with respect to the Agreement State program. The staff should develop the combined deliverable under the assumption that the views contained in these SRMs regarding content continue to be the settled views of the Commission, including for all matters in those SRMs not bearing directly on staff's request here.

With respect to certain statements by the staff that they wish to remove content from the policy statements because such content is more appropriately conveyed in staff-level documents such as guidance, I note two points. First, Commission policy statements are important communication vehicles for the Commission to broadcast its policy views to impacted entities outside the agency. As such, they should not be written at so high a level that they are devoid of meaningful content. Second, some of the SRM direction being discussed here already instructed the staff to "update [both] the Commission Policy Statement . . . and associated guidance documents" (emphasis added), giving the staff existing liberty to navigate content between the policy statement and staff-level documents, as appropriate.
