# Chairman Klein's comments on SECY-06-0195, Transition Plan for the Regulation of Certain Byproduct Material Mandated by the Energy Policy Act of 2005

I commend the staff for developing a comprehensive draft byproduct material transition plan, and I approve the proposed approach for developing and publishing the final plan. I also approve seeking early State review and comment on the draft transition plan, as well as the use of the criteria in the Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program (IMPEP) as a basis to determine the adequacy of Agreement State programs to license the materials covered under the expanded definition of byproduct material. Rather than performing special evaluations in cases where a new Agreement State has not yet had an IMPEP review, or an Agreement State program was found to need improvement, the staff should accept the Governor's certification that the State has a program for licensing byproduct material as adequate assurance that the program meets the requirements set forth in the Energy Policy Act of 2005. The staff should subsequently verify the adequacy of the implementation at the next scheduled IMPEP.

# Commissioner Jaczko's Comments on SECY-06-0195 Transition Plan for the Regulation of Certain Byproduct Materials Mandated by the Energy Policy Act of 2005

I approve the staff's recommended approach for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to transition its authority to regulate certain byproduct materials required by the Energy Policy Act (EPAct) of 2005 to the states. Consistent with the EPAct, I support discontinuing the NRC's authority for these materials in agreement state programs where the Governor certifies that the state has a regulatory program to cover the new class of materials. In order to fulfill the EPAct's requirements that the NRC determine the adequacy of such programs to protect public health and safety, I strongly support the staff's recommendation to make an adequacy determination using the IMPEP criteria for states that have less than adequate IMPEP findings or have not had an IMPEP review.
