Retrospective Review Under Executive Order 13579: Plan for Retrospective Analysis of Existing Rules; Request for Comment; 10 CFR Chapter 1 (NRC-2011-0246)

On November 23, 2012, the NRC published in the *Federal Register* (77 FR 70123) a draft Plan for the retrospective analysis of the NRC's existing regulations. The draft Plan describes the processes and activities that the NRC uses to determine whether any of its regulations should be modified, streamlined, expanded, or repealed. This action is part of the NRC's voluntary implementation of Executive Order 13579, "Regulation and Independent Regulatory Agencies," issued by the President on July 11, 2011. The NRC has requested public comment on the draft Plan. Comments must be submitted by February 6, 2013.

On November 29, 2012, staff from the Information and Records Services Division attended a working group meeting at the Controlled Unclassified Information Office, National Archives and Records Administration. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss comments received concerning the marking and consolidated guidance drafts. The discussions regarding marking included whether portion markings should be required, marking placement, marking length, and the requirement for multiple marking types for each level. The discussion regarding the consolidated drafts included storage, challenges, electronic considerations, waivers, dissemination, and decontrol.

<u>Public Meeting with Nuclear Energy Institute on National Fire Protection Association Standard</u> 805

On November 29, 2012, the staff held a public meeting with Nuclear Energy Institute representatives to discuss issues requiring management attention related to National Fire Protection Association Standard 805.

Public Meeting with Nuclear Energy Institute on Probabilistic Risk Assessment

On November 30, 2012, the staff held a public meeting with Nuclear Energy Institute and industry representatives to discuss questions related to fire probabilistic risk assessment (PRA) methods. Electrical panel fire methods and the prioritization of fire PRA methods were discussed.

Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (RES) Items of Interest Week Ending November 30, 2012

<u>Publication of Regulatory Guide 1.92, "Combining Modal Responses and Spatial Components in Seismic Response Analysis"</u>

November 19, 2012, the staff announced release of Regulatory Guide (RG) 1.92, Rev. 3 as an administratively changed guide in the *Federal Register* (77 FR 69509). RG 1.92 provides guidance that the NRC staff considers acceptable for combining modal responses and spatial components in seismic response analysis of nuclear power plant structures, systems, and components important to safety. Changes from the previous version were editorial, with no substantive change in the Staff Regulatory Guidance. Among the changes in text were the footnote on the first page, the Congressional Review Act language at the end of the Introduction on page two, and the Implementation Section (pages 17 and 18). Standards Development Organizations Meeting

Staff from RES participated in a meeting of the Nuclear Energy Standards Coordination Collaborative on November 29, 2012, at the American National Standard Institute Headquarters in Washington, DC. This meeting is a joint initiative with the Department of Energy to identify and develop standards to meet the needs of the nuclear industry. The Regulatory Guide Development Branch (RGDB) in RES gave a presentation on the NRC's process for reviewing and endorsing standards.

In addition, RGDB and the Japan Lessons Learned Directorate held a public meeting on Friday, November 30° 2012 with the American Nuclear Society, representatives of other Standards Development Organizations (SDOs), and industry stakeholders to assess whether the SDOs could develop standards to facilitate addressing lessons learned from the Fukushima Dai-ichi event, principally Tier 3 activities.
