Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR) Items of Interest Week Ending November 29, 2013

ROP Monthly Public Meeting

On November 20, 2013, the staff held the Reactor Oversight Process (ROP) monthly public meeting. Discussions included updates on operational support, inspection, assessment topics, and possible changes to the performance indicator guidance. The staff and industry representatives also discussed Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs).

Public Meeting on ROP Enhancements to the Assessment Program

On November 21, 2013, the staff held a public meeting on ROP enhancements to the assessment program. The staff and industry representatives discussed the goal and scope of the project. The discussed topics included effectiveness of substantive cross-cutting issues (SCCIs), timeliness of supplemental inspections, ROP Action Matrix column criteria, and the significance determination process (SDP).

<u>Issuance of South Texas Project Final Environmental Impact Statement</u>

On November 21, 2013, the staff issued the Final Supplement 48 to NUREG-1437, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants, Regarding South Texas Project." The final supplemental environmental impact statement (FSEIS) represents the completion of the staff's environmental review of the license renewal application submitted by South Texas Project Nuclear Operating Company. As documented in the FSEIS, the staff determined that the adverse environmental impacts of license renewal for South Texas Project are not so great that preserving the option of license renewal for energy-planning decision-makers would be unreasonable.

International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) Meeting in Stockholm

From November 25 - 27, 2013, the staff attended an IEC meeting in Stockholm, Sweden. This is a Committee on the Safety of Nuclear Installations (CSNI) effort with IEC to develop a standard for improving and standardizing the robustness of offsite power systems. The purpose of this trip was to provide U.S. experience and improvements made after the 2003 power blackout in Northeast USA and issuance of NRC Generic Letter 2006-02.
