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Office of Administration (ADM) Items of Interest Week Ending April 25, 2014

Revise and Integrate All Safety and Environmental Regulations Related to Spent Fuel Storage and Disposal: Petition for Rulemaking; Acceptance and Docketing; 10 CFR Part 51 (PRM-51-30; NRC-2014-0014)

On April 21, 2014, the NRC published a document in the *Federal Register* (79 FR 22055) regarding acceptance and docketing of a petition for rulemaking (PRM) from Diane Curran on behalf of 34 environmental organizations (the petitioner), dated December 20, 2013, as corrected on January 7, 2014. The petitioner requests that the NRC revise and integrate all regulations that relate to the environmental impacts of spent fuel storage and disposal. The NRC is not instituting a public comment period for this PRM at this time.

Performance-Based Emergency Core Cooling Systems Cladding Acceptance Criteria: Proposed Rule; Extension of Comment Period; 10 CFR Parts 50 and 52 (RIN 3150-AH42; NRC-2008-0332, NRC-2012-0041; NRC-2012-0042; NRC-2012-0043)

On April 22, 2014, the NRC published an extension of comment period in the *Federal Register* (79 FR 22456) regarding a proposed rule it published in the *Federal Register* on March 24, 2014 (79 FR 16106). The proposed rule would revise the acceptance criteria for the emergency core cooling system for light-water nuclear power reactors. The NRC is also seeking public comment on three draft regulatory guides that would support the implementation of the proposed rule. The public comment period for the proposed rule and associated draft guidance was to have ended on June 9, 2014. The public comment period for information collection aspects of this rule was to have ended on April 23, 2014. Due to requests from members of the public, the NRC has extended the comment periods for the proposed rule, the associated draft guidance, and the information collection aspects to August 21, 2014.
