
Industry Trends Program

Performance Criteria

- Strategic outcomes
- Performance measures
- Abnormal occurrences (AOs)
- Significant enforcement actions
- Trending review of event data
- SECY-02-0216 and SECY-08-0135

Strategic Outcomes & Performance Measures

- All strategic outcomes were realized
- Performance measures were all within established goals

Abnormal Occurrences

- 15 AOs in FY 2010
- All AOs in FY 2010 were medical-related events
- Number of AOs is small compared to number of uses with radioactive material

Licensee and NRC Program Performance

- Two nuclear materials licensees met the significant performance issues criteria for FY 2010
- No significant trending issues
- No NRC program gaps or failures
