- 1. On page 3 of Framework document, first full paragraph, change line 4 to read ... "activities have been enhanced by these requirements integration with the Nation's foreign policy."
- 2. On page 4 of Framework document, change section II.A.4 to read ... "Submit required reports under the terms of the Convention on Nuclear Safety, including a high-quality submission for the Revised U.S. National Report to the IAEA Nuclear Safety Convention National Report Review Meeting, and provide robust NRC participation in the Review meeting, pursuant to the SRM of April 24, 2001. Similar requirements will apply once the Senate gives its advice and consent to ratification of the Joint Convention on the Safety of Spent Fuel Management and on the Safety of Radioactive Waste Management is notified by the Senate and implemented ation in the U.S. is commenced.

The staff should modify Section II.C. of Framework document, Additional Priority-Setting Considerations, to include a discussion which allows for early, efficient Commission notification of, and involvement in, policy issues consistent with Management Directive 9.14 and the Staff Memorandum dated September 4, 2001 (M010814).
