I. SECY-98-022- PETITION FOR COMMISSION REVIEW OF DIRECTOR'S DECISION ON PADUCAH SEISMIC UPGRADES CERTIFICATE AMENDMENT REQUEST

The Commission⁽¹⁾ approved an order responding to a petition by the U.S. Enrichment Corporation (USEC) for review of the Director of the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards' decision (Director's Decision) denying, in part, USEC's certificate amendment request regarding the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP) seismic upgrades.

The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order denying the petition and requiring USEC to perform the modifications required by the Compliance Plan without further delay, as stated in the Director's Decision on December 16, 1997.
