The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff on a planned approach to force-on-force (FOF) enhancements; safeguards information local area network and electronic safe expansion; cyber security; part 73 power reactor licensing; integrated pilot comprehensive exercise plans; hostile action-based drills; and facility and operational readiness.

The staff should continue to engage with industry to understand and address impediments to voluntary participation and encourage licensees to transition to the new Emergency Response Data System (ERDS), inform the Commission of any related issues that require Commission attention, and provide quarterly updates via CA note on the status of licensees' transition to the new ERDS system.

The staff should report back to the Commission on how the proposed enhancements to the FOF physical protection significance determination process (PPSDP) would alter the CY 2009 FOF exercise findings.
