ANNETTE VIETTI-COOK: The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order responding to a request by the New England Coalition for an Order directing the NRC Staff to refrain from issuing an operating license amendment to Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee and Entergy Nuclear Operations Inc., together Entergy, which would allow an increase in the maximum power at Entergy's Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station until after completion of a pending adjudication before the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board. The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order which denies the New England Coalition request for a stay of the power uprate license amendment. Would you please affirm your votes?
