The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order to address the intervention petition, hearing request, and application for stay filed by Friends of the Earth concerning the replacement of the steam generators at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station, Units 2 and 3. The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order, which refers the 50.59 argument to the Executive Director for Operations for consideration under 10 CFR 2.206; refers the Confirmatory Action Letter argument to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel for consideration pursuant to Commission direction; and denies, without prejudice, the stay request and the request for a discretionary hearing.
