NRC Assigns New Senior Resident Inspector at Nine Mile Point



Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in King of Prussia, Pa., have selected Gregory Stock as the new senior resident inspector at the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station. The two-unit site is located in Scriba, N.Y.

Since joining the agency in 2013, Stock has worked as a reactor engineer in the NRC Region I office and as a resident inspector at Nine Mile Point. Most recently, he was a resident inspector at the James A. FitzPatrick nuclear power plant. Prior to joining the NRC, Stock worked at the Norfolk Naval Shipyard,

specializing in propulsion machinery. He earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from Penn State University.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant site has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring major work projects and interacting with plant workers and the public. Stock joins Resident Inspectors Beth Sienel and Jacob Dolecki at Nine Mile Point.
